

For Teams attending the Opening Ceremony on April 12

Schedule of Event are as Follow:

2:30 pm Players can start Checking in to the Designated Fields.

3:00 pm Home Run Derby Starts up on Completion

Home Run Derby

1. Two (2) players from each team will participate in the Home Run Derby
2. A Coach or person chosen by player will pitch to the player. Each player will receive a total of 5 outs. An Out is defined as any swing that does not result in a Home Run over the fence in fair territory.
3. The player with the highest number of home runs will be the Winner. If there is no home runs hit, The Player with the longest hit will be declared the Winner. If there is a tie, those players tied advance will a second round in which they will receive 2 Outs. This process will continue until there is a clear Winner. Example, if here are 3 players tied after the first round, they will compete in a second round with just 2 outs. If after there are 2 players tied they will do a 3rd round with those 2 players and each player gets 2 outs and so on.
4. Distances to the Fence will be set to encourage home runs by moving hitting boxes north of home plate and closer to the infield.

Around the Horn

1. Five (5) players from each team will be allowed to participate. The Players will take their positions in the infield (1b,2b, 3b, SS, C).
2. Catcher Starts the time by throwing to third base. Timer starts after the throw is released from the catcher's hand.
3. The Catcher will throw to third baseman, third-baseman throws to second baseman, second-baseman throw to shortstop, short throws to first baseman and first-baseman throws to catcher. The time will stop when the catcher receives the throw from the first-baseman.
4. All fielders must stay in appropriate area when receiving / throwing the ball.
5. ANY DROPPED BALLS OR BAD THROWS ARE CONSIDERED LIVE AND TIME WILL KEEP RUNNING!
6. NO PRACTICE ROUND FOR EACH TEAM.

Speed around the Bases

1. Three (3) player from each team will be allowed to participate. Each player will start inside the batter's box and run the bases.
2. Time will start on first step (on player's movement) and end when touching home plate.
3. A missed base results in a 3 second penalty
